As the Temporary, Lines Supervisor, your duties will include:

- Provide support to the Manager in coordinating and managing operations, maintenance and construction of electrical distribution systems and streetlighting under the direction of PUC Services Inc. This will include out of town contracts through the safe, efficient, and effective deployment of available resources;
- Conduct a variety of activities to deploy available staff and equipment required to maintain, operate and construct electrical facilities;
- Provide overall development and training of staff;
- Monitor health and safety compliance through workplace inspections and crew visits, and initiates corrective action, in conjunction with the Department Manager and the Manager, Safety;
- Establish priorities, schedule availability of staff and ensure accurate payroll time and material reporting;
- Assess short/long term plans in order to assist in the development of annual and long-term budgets and purchases up to approved levels; and
- Ensure job procedures are followed.

Qualifications:

- Preference for a post-secondary diploma in Electrical Engineering Technology or related discipline;
- A minimum of twelve years' experience in electrical distribution operations, preferably in a utility environment:
- A valid MEA or EUSA Powerline Technician Certificate or equivalent is an asset;
- Sound knowledge of and demonstrated experience in electrical distribution operations, maintenance and construction;
- Strong knowledge of related legislation, codes, standards and practices;
- Strong interpersonal, organizational, time management, and oral/written communication skills;
- Demonstrated ability to exercise sound judgment in decision making;
- Ability to motivate and lead change through the use of team leadership skills;
- Strong understanding of project management principles;
- Well-developed analytical, organizational, and technical skills;
